

## Chapter Board

*Use these discussion points to recruit new or existing members to join the chapter board.*

- **Introduce the concept of a chapter board:**
  - *Your passion for making an impact in your local community would make you a great fit for a chapter board.*
  - *A chapter board is a team of Modern Woodmen members who work together to bring members together and make an impact in their local community. Chapter boards are really impact teams.*
- **Share opportunities offered by joining an impact team:**
  - *By being part of an impact team, you'll have plenty of opportunities to be involved in the community. The team is responsible for planning events that focus on social, educational and volunteer activities that benefit members of the chapter and our local community.*
- **Explain the time commitment involved:**
  - *The time commitment for an impact team is only 1-2 hours, at most, per month. You would attend board meeting at least twice a year and monthly activities.*
  - *Depending on the role you serve on the team, you can be involved for 1-3 years.*
- **Give a copy of the chapter office recruiting brochure:**
  - *Here is the chapter board flyer. It provides an overview of the responsibilities of each role on the impact team.*
- **End the conversation:**
  - If the prospective team members want to be part of the chapter board:
    - *I'm glad you want to make a difference in your community by providing volunteer, educational and social opportunities for new and existing members! Here are the next steps for joining the team.*
  - If the prospective team member is unsure and would like more information:
    - *Try your best to answer any questions he/she might have. Use the FAQ handout, if needed. If you're unsure of an answer, please contact the Fraternal Department at ext. 7339 for help.*
  - If the prospective team members is currently not interested:
    - *Please take this flyer. It contains more information and how to contact me in case you change your mind or think of anyone else who would be interested in making a positive impact in the community.*
