## Trivia Contest Rules

1) Each team is assigned to a table. Find your table and know your table number.
2) Each table has 10 answer sheets (one per round) and a pencil. Select a team captain, who is responsible for writing the team's final answers. The team captain should write legibly. (No credit is given for illegible answers.)
3) The table captain should write the team's table number on all 10 answer sheets and, with team members' help, estimate the team's final score on the Round 1 answer sheet. This estimate will serve as a tiebreaker in case of a tie. (Total possible points equals the number of rounds played $x$ 100)
4) No reference materials of any kind - including online resources - are permitted. If a player leaves the room for any reason during a round, he or she should not re-enter until his/her team's answer sheet is turned in.
5) Each trivia question will be read only twice. Teams have one minute to decide on their answer before the next question is read.
6) At the end of each round, teams have two minutes to discuss and finalize their answers. Runners will then collect and deliver the answer sheets to the judges.
7) The judges' decisions are final.
8) After all teams have submitted their answer sheets for a particular round, the correct answers to the round's questions will be read.
9) "Mulligans" can be used in place of an answer for full credit and are available for purchase before the start of the first round. Teams can use a maximum of 10 Mulligans: one for each round.
10) At the end of the trivia contest, the tables with the most points are ranked first-, second- and third-place.
