Best practices for using electronic invitations

- ✓ Review this document in its entirety.
- ✓ Speak to the member audience. Although Fraternal Department team members review the request for approval, we are not the only audience. The chapter or youth club member who receives the invitation is your most important audience.
- ✓ Think about how the information will sound and look when added to the e-invitation templates. While we do not have a preview available with the activity request form, you can view sample messages on the activity request form and within this document beginning on page 2. We also "map" a list of standard e-invitation fields to the fields on the activity request form starting on page 5.
- ✓ Include information members will need to know to attend or participate.
- ✓ Be detailed but concise. Provide members with information but avoid being too wordy.
- ✓ Always include a location, even if it is a virtual event. When hosting a virtual event, use the location fields to share the online meeting details. For example, the location name could be Zoom. Include the meeting ID and password (or the link) in the address lines. For city, enter Your Home or Your Town.
- ✓ Avoid using ALL CAPS unless it is necessary. The voice used for the phone invitations will read each letter of the word as though it was an acronym or initialism, such as YMCA. For example, "COME JOIN US" is read "C-O-M-E J-O-I-N U-S."
- ✓ Be selective with punctuation. While we believe we've addressed all the issues with commas and other punctuation, it's best to avoid using unnecessary punctuation.
- ✓ Check the activity request form and/or the postcard for spelling and grammar.
- ✓ Note that we are unable to include all details in text messages due to the limited characters.
 - Include the most critical information in the fields that display in the text message. This
 includes the activity title, date, time, location name and location address.

Sample Messages


Below are sample messages of the initial invitations for chapters and youth service clubs.

The 10-day reminder provides the same information from the initial invitation but states that the activity is approaching. The 3-day reminder provides the same information from the initial invitation but states that the activity is a few days away.

The versions with RSVP (chapters only) will include a statement instructing members to contact the leader to RSVP.

The activity canceled states the activity has been canceled. It includes the activity title, activity date, time and chapter/youth club number. Members are asked to contact the fraternal leader with any questions.

Electronic Invitations Field Mapping

Because text messages have limited characters, the templates are designed to provide basic information. The text messages encourage interested members to call the fraternal leader for more details.

Below we provide a screenshot of each type of message – email and text – along with a chart showing how the information in a typical request form maps to the template.
